Budget for material resources for disabled and chronically ill students

To promote inclusion - in particular accessibility - TUM has a budget for the purchase of material resources.

Who is eligible to apply?

All students and prospective students admitted to TUM with a disability or chronic illness as well as faculty representatives are entitled to apply for material resources within the framework of accessibility.

What is the purpose of the material resources?

The purchase of material resources should not only promote accessibility, but also compensate for disadvantages.

Where do I submit the application?

Those eligible should submit the application to the TUM Center for Study and Teaching (TUM CST), Student Advising: Studying with Special Needs.

Please make sure to attach a cost estimate for the requested materials!

How long does it take to process the application?

If all the necessary documents are provided, you will usually receive feedback after 4 weeks at the latest.

What happens if my application is approved?

If the application is approved, a contract will be concluded between the TUM CST and the person concerned so that the material resources are made available to the applicant. After completion of the study program, this material resource must be returned to the TUM CST.

What reasons can lead to a negative decision on my application?

The application may be rejected, for example,

- if the budget is exhausted,
- if the costs of the requested material resource can be covered by the health insurance fund, the pension office or other institutions and therefore the TUM CST department is not responsible for authorisation.
